LACE: LEADERSHIP IN ARTS & CULTURAL EDUCATION

is a new program crafted by Creative Generation emerging from a global study on the topic integrating theories of mindfulness, critical reflection, arts entrepreneurship, and educational futures to cultivate the next generation of leaders working in the cultural and education sectors. The aim of this work is to prepare individuals who are equipped to reimagine the structures of leaders, evolve cultural and education ecosystems, and develop sustainable systems which cultivate the creative capabilities of young people.

Beginning with an assumption of expertise in individual arts and cultural education practice, this curriculum builds on a foundation of research conducted in a global context examining core capabilities of those leaders in the arts and cultural education sector: unlearning, bridging, navigating, and holding tensions. Participants will explore reimagined concepts of distributive collective leadership, eldership, and practical tactics to envision the paradigm shifts needed in their work. Participants will creatively examine their own skills and create future-focused strategies focused on innovating practice in their own professional contexts.





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PROGRAM DESIGN

This program will be offered in multiple modalities and formats to meet the needs of attendees and presenting partners. In each format, attendees will experience three units while building a constructive cohort.

Unit 1: With a focus on new models of leadership, participants will critically reflect to examine their own experiences.

Unit 2: Applying the principles of arts entrepreneurship, participants will interrogate their values and apply to new leadership models.

Unit 3: Working together, attendees will creatively explore their visions for the future of arts and cultural education in their professional context.



PROGRAM DESIGN

Continuous Evaluation & Networking:

As a compulsory part of the program, participants will continue discussions in a virtual space between and after sequential units. At the conclusion of Unit 3, participants will enact their Strategic Futures Plans in their own communities over a period of time with the support of program facilitators and peers.

Credential:

After appropriate evaluation of participation, and upon submission and assessment of a critical reflection essay, The Academy for Creative Leadership and its partners will grant a certificate of completion.
